Ladies and Gentlemen of Chicagoland Polonia:

I write to you to encourage your attendance this Wednesday morning, at the Meet & Greet with gubernatorial candidate, Mr. J.B. Pritzker. On February 28th at the Copernicus Center, we proud Polish Americans can state our concerns and needs for our Community.
